Why don't you think about coral in Okinawa and the global environment with us?

It is said that approximately 380 species of corals inhabit the seas of Okinawa. In 1998, a worldwide rise in sea water temperature caused a large-scale bleaching phenomenon in many areas, which was also seen throughout Okinawa Prefecture.

Kariyushi Hotels, as a beneficiary of economic activities utilizing Okinawa's rich "marine resources," has been involved in marine conservation activities in order to respond to such changes in the marine environment. In 2008, The ICRI International Year of the Reef, the international effort to conserve coral reefs became more active, and on this occasion we launched the Coral Restoration Project to engage in full-scale coral conservation activities.

As part of the "Coral Restoration Project," we would like to develop "KARIYUSHI SANGO PARK" in 2024 to communicate the importance of the ocean and coral and our conservation activities to many people through "learning" and "experience".



2008
In support of The ICRI International Year of the Reef 2008, a global coral conservation project, the company has established its own "Kariyushi Coral Forest Project" and is involved in coral conservation activities, including planting approximately 10,000 coral seedlings.

Glass boat (pleasure boat): We will have a look and feel at the current state of the sea and think about making and planting seedlings.

After the workshop, participants will experience making seedlings using coral and sticks. You can write messages on the sticks, so you can make your own original coral seedlings by writing or illustrating your wishes for coral growth and clean ocean.

Visitors are invited to touch coral and other sea creatures in the touch pool.

The coral seedlings will be planted at a later date with the cooperation of the Onna Village Fisheries Cooperative Association. We will continue to monitor their growth through regular observation and environmental surveys.
